

# Terror

Before I ate, I knew not hunger  
Before I desired, I knew not wealth  
Before I feared, I knew not danger  
Before I woke, I knew not sleep

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It can be strange for humans of the present day to learn of the movements that led to *The Age of Terror*, as our ways of life have strayed so far from those of the past. Our ancestral family lived in a *formicary* society, blindly motivated by the collective e-motions that, almost exclusively, dominated the human race for several centuries (as well as a few other races, including some fungi and domesticated rodents, which we will not address in this paper). This text is an attempt to offer some insight to the evolutionary movements of the human species and its' entanglement with the entity *Terror*.

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From our current perspective, we can clearly see the heavy impact of the e-motions that ruled Human Kind for thousands of years, an impact which peaked in the period between the late 19<sup>th</sup> and mid 21<sup>st</sup> century. The oppressive force was, however, less obvious to those suffering under its' reign: Like a veil, the e-motions covered the collective outlook, and thus shaped the reality and self-understanding of the vast majority of humanity. Indeed, it was nearly impossible for the 21<sup>st</sup> century person to even imagine an alternative mode of perception outside of the *fear/desire* driven state. Being trapped in the patterns of elemental identification the, very appropriately called, *individual* perceived itself as an isolated unit within an environment of an alienating external world. This "exterior" was dominated by conventions and regulations of behaviour, and the varying norms and ethics functioned to create an even stronger conviction of the obscure belief that nature was, in fact, an *Other*.

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Please, dear reader, before I continue this paper, I encourage you to imagine the suffering such a position of perceived isolation will have caused. And hopefully this compassion-exercise will offer us an entry point to forgiveness for the mass destruction our for-parents caused upon this planet and the struggle they left for the generations to follow them.

## Human

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As we know now, all objects within the connected oneness, including words, concepts, thoughts and e-motions, have their own evolutionary trajectories, interweaving gracefully in and out of one another's veracities. The human trajectory has moved at a relatively slower pace than many of its' contemporaries, such as octopi, derogatories and head lice, who all as species reached their apparent evolutionary peak in 2024/25CE.

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Within the last decade, we have come to learn that the slow development of the human race has led to several recorded cases of organised, external interventions in order to

incite the species to the next evolutionary stage. This paper will only address the first known case, which occurred in 798.000 BCE, when the six salivary amylase genes were implanted in the human species (most other animals only have two), by an unknown source of non-Terra origin. The genes were then triggered through the artificial introduction of the common potato, which offered the glucose needed to activate an additional 48% of the human brain's latent capacity. From this step of evolution, the human race developed the majority of its' cognitive and intellectual skills, including the capacity to self-reflect and self-observe. Through this new self-awareness, the perception of separation was created, and thus the Ego-mind was born.

Despite the increase in intellectual abilities, the *hunter/gatherer* instincts (later known as the *fear/desire* state) were left untouched, still functioning as the main human drive. As in the case for most original make-ups of Terra-originated species, the *hunter/gatherer* instincts initially functioned as tools for survival. For the human ape this meant the ability to self-protect, as well as the inherent desire for reproduction and nourishment. With the *hunter/gatherer* instincts intact, combined with the newfound intellectual properties, the human mind was immersed into *thinking*.

As the Ego-mind quickly learned how to protect itself from bears and competing tribes, the fear of dangerous predators was replaced with fear derived from abstract speculations of status and value. The instinctual motions, which had previously functioned to ensure survival, were now gradually experienced through intellectual interpretation. An example of such an interpretive experience could be seen in how the naturally occurring motion of increased energy from a release of adrenaline in life-threatening circumstances was now unnecessarily applied in situations of social degradation, and given new titles such as *shame* and *anxiety*. These misinterpretations are what we today know as the e-motions. The e-motions created a state of constant flux between searching and resisting: A mind without satisfaction.

### **Terror**

Through the industrial- and later technological evolution, the human species progressively found itself closer to a reality without any risk of extinction. However, despite immense improvements in intellectual and organisational skills, Homo Sapia remained e-motionally immature in the years between 798.000BCE up until the final collapse in 2068CE. From inquiry, we know that the e-motion *Terror* was created as a result of another collective misinterpretation of the instinctual signals of the tool-body, within the final time-stretch of this period. Largely due to the predominating simulated experience of separation, *Terror* eventually grew to be one of the most expansive entities ever to exist alongside humans.

To this day, there is no known documentation of the original seed of *Terror*. The first documented form we have, was discovered in the Proto-Indo-European *Tres*; to tremble. It has also been found in a later form of the Latin *Terrorem*; fright, fear. (However, it is widely regarded by historical researchers that the entity had existed in several earlier forms, as the e-motion connected to the word is documented to emerge at least 978 years in advance of *Tres*.) In the development between the presumed infancy as *Tres*, to its'

more mature form of *Terrorem*, we can observe a rapidly moving evolution, comparable in speed only to a very few species, such as guppies and Nano communication lards. The evolution of the word-object tightly followed the trajectory of its' corresponding e-motion; from initially defining the physical properties induced by instinctual reactions, to later describing the projected qualities of the abstracted interpretation.

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As a result of the human races' ever-stronger sense of internal alienation, the intensity of the Ego-identification had accelerated so rapidly in the beginning of the 21<sup>st</sup> century that *Terror* inflated by approximately 750% in less than 40 years. As a result of this inflation, *Terror* reached the limits of its' capacity as an *internal* reactive e-motion. In order to survive it was forced into a new step of evolution. Through transforming its' identity into the external aggressor itself, *Terror* took on the role of a collective ghost object (previously known as hyper object). The object grew away from the original form of misinterpreted defence mechanism, into a misinterpreted predator.

As we all know today, the aggressor and the defender are two faces of the same head, but at the beginning of the 21<sup>st</sup> century people still lived according to ethical dogmas set up by the religious institutions they had long forsaken. These dogmas, dualist of nature, fuelled the e-motions and tethered them even stronger to the human mind. Eventually *Terror* reached such an impressive level of power that it is hard not to look back with a sense of admiration. By 2026CE the object inhabited at least 40% of the daily e-motional human experience.

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It was not until 2067CE, in the midst of the final world war, that technology advanced to allow humans to communicate with, what is still clumsily known as, 'non- animated' entities. The first communication between former West President and biologist Jill Stein (1950-2094CE) and the kelp unit known as Migula 1, has been recognised as the initial moment of humanity awakening to it's current stage of evolution. We can thank Migula 1 for most of the original texts on *Terra*, as well as the early teachings on lowering the collective *Yang*.

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*Terror* quickly lost its' momentum from that point, initially attempting to hide in the structures of gender and other tightly woven norms, but eventually it failed to sustain any kind of integrity. Today *Terror* can be experienced through historical e-motion simulacrum travels, and very occasionally it will be spotted between the sub-atoms in the dust trails from what was previously known as *you*.
